

WORKMAN TOWNSHIP MONTHLY MEETING

OCTOBER 17, 2018

Workman Township October 17, 2018 monthly meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman James Berg with the reciting of our Pledge of Allegiance. All board members were present along with two visitors. The agenda was approved with a motion by Fred Kamrowski, seconded by Marvin Holsten.

Minutes of the September 19, 2018 meeting were approved as read with a motion by Marvin Holsten, seconded by Fred Kamrowski.

Treasurer's report showed a balance of \$17,625.21 distributed as follows: General \$10,309.11, Road & Bridge \$4,480.69, Fire \$1,273.14 and Cemetery \$1,562.27. Check #14825 issued 6/20/2018 has been lost by the school. We will void the check and issue a new check in November. Interest on our CD was in the amount of \$126.79. Clerk's balances are in agreement with the treasurer. The treasurer's report was approved with a motion by Fred Kamrowski, seconded by Marvin Holsten.

Supervisor's Reports:

Fire: Palisade Fire Department will hold their yearly meeting on October 27, 2018. There has been no contact from McGregor Fire Department.

Cemetery: The storm brought a tree down. Contact will be made with Erik's Lawn Service regarding the mowing down of some of the newly planted trees. A motion was made by Fred Kamrowski, seconded by Marvin Holsten to deduct \$100 from his next bill. A letter of explanation will be included with the check. Flags have been taken down for the winter season. An additional 50 brochures will be ordered.

Buildings: Our township hall will be closed for the winter and meetings will be held at the Palisade Community Center starting November 21, 2018 at 4:00 p.m.

Roads: The 10 mph sign stolen from 510th has been purchased and will be replaced. James Berg has spoken with Shamrock Township regarding trees on 512th Lane in need of removal. Shamrock will take care of it. Up North Riders requested we reopen an abandoned road between Hwy 65 and Cty 63. They were told there would be no use to the township for this action and would have to deal with the owner. Road check for November 1, 2018 will be posted and published. (Was later changed to November 2, 2018.)

Grader: No report

Claims to be paid were read by the clerk. The claim for Fred Kamrowski's mileage was overlooked and will be issued in November. Marvin Holsten made a motion to pay claims, seconded by Fred Kamrowski.

Old Business: FEMA forms were e-mailed in an 8 X 14 format which had to be sent to McGregor Printing to make copies. James Berg will meet with a rep next week. Snowplowing contract has been signed with Darlow Excavating for the 2018-19 season. A supervisor must call each time plowing is needed. November election has been posted. A motion was made by Marvin Holsten, seconded by Fred Kamrowski that we send clerk and treasurer to the January 3, 2019 new clerk training season. Betty Berg is continuing to update our new cemetery program.

New Business: Mileage certification will stay the same as 2018 for 2019. A motion was made by Marvin Holsten, seconded by Fred Kamrowski to pay time for James Berg and Fred Kamrowski to attend the Annual MAT Convention in November.

Other Business: There was a brief discussion on broadband.

Next meeting was set for November 21, 2018 @ 4:00 p.m. at the Palisade Community Center. We adjourned at 10:21 a.m. with a motion by Fred Kamrowski, seconded by Marvin Holsten.
