

**WORKMAN TOWNSHIP MONTHLY MEETING
NOVEMBER 21, 2018**

Workman Township November monthly meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. at the Palisade Community Center, by Chairman James Berg with the reciting of our Pledge of Allegiance to our flag. All board members and our clerk elect were present. The agenda was approved with a motion by Fred Kamrowski, seconded by Marvin Holsten.

Minutes of the October 17, 2018 meeting were approved as read with a motion by Fred Kamrowski, seconded by Marvin Holsten.

Treasurer's report showed a balance of \$14,171.52 distributed as follows: General \$8,629.07, Road & Bridge \$3,567.92, Fire \$1,273.14 and Cemetery \$701.39. Clerk's balances are in agreement with the treasurer. James Berg indicated we should receive about \$31,000 from FEMA. It was suggested \$20,000 be placed in a CD to replace the one cashed in earlier. Treasurer's report was approved with a motion by Fred Kamrowski, seconded by Marvin Holsten.

Supervisor's Reports

Fire: James Berg reported on the Palisade Fire Department yearly meeting. He also indicated there has been discussion on finding a suitable emergency drop zone for helicopter use, with both Shamrock and Palisade showing interest. McGregor has a new mayor and it is not known what direction the fire department issue will go.

Cemetery: Additional brochures have been printed.

Building: Closed for the winter months. It will be kept plowed for security and posting.

Roads: The fall road check was completed on November 1st and a copy will be attached to the minutes.

Grader: No report

Claims to be paid, in the amount of \$10,297.31, were read by the clerk and approved with a motion by Fred Kamrowski, seconded by Marvin Holsten. Payroll was \$3,994.72 for the month.

Correspondence: Lakes & Pines newsletter, Mille Lacs Outlet and Notice of Review for Settler's Ridge. Discussion took place on Settler's Ridge plans to expand with agreement it would have no concern for our township.

Old Business: An additional meeting with FEMA will take place on December 12, 2018 and supervisors will plan to attend. Certificates of Election have been issued for Fred Kamrowski re-elected as supervisor A and Wanda Essen as clerk. James Berg reported on the annual MAT Convention held in Duluth.

New Business: The lighting contract for the cemetery was received from Mille Lacs Electric and signed for returning. Palisade Fire Department contract for 2020 in the amount of \$8,189.11, was received and signed. Arrowhead Regional Development Commission is seeking a representative from Aitkin County for their board.

Next meeting was set for December 19, 2018 @ 4:00 p.m. to be held at the Palisade Community Center. A motion to adjourn was made by Fred Kamrowski, seconded by Marvin Holsten. We adjourned at 10:30 a.m.
