

## Workman Township Monthly Meeting

August 16, 2017

Workman Township monthly meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman James Berg. All Board members and two visitors were present. We opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to our flag. The agenda for the meeting was approved with a motion by Fred Kamrowski, seconded by Marvin Holsten.

The minutes of the July 19, 2017 meeting were approved, with two street names corrected, with a motion by Marvin Holsten, seconded by Fred Kamrowski.

Treasurer's report showed a balance of \$58,803.29 distributed as follows: General Fund \$15,517.71, Road and Bridge Fund \$39,525.24, Fire Fund \$1,857.34 and Cemetery Fund \$1,903.00. Clerk's balances are in agreement with the treasurer. The report was approved with a motion by Fred Kamrowski, seconded by Marvin Holsten.

### Supervisor's Reports

**Fire:** Nothing to report

**Cemetery:** The hedge plants are growing well. The new flag pole is still leaning slightly. Another call was received with interest on buying a burial plot. The appointment had to be rescheduled due to rain. The computer program should be ready to go by the end of September. New signs should be completed shortly after school begins this fall. We are still looking for someone to straighten leaning headstones and benches.

**Building:** No report

**Roads:** Fredrickson has completed graveling on Grouse Street. Weeds including canadian thistle, poison ivy and wild parsnip have been sprayed. Dale Hansen will be checking on obtaining a license to spray so he is able to do the spraying next year. A bad culvert needs to be replaced by Wolds. Kern has not started on graveling of 270<sup>th</sup> Street. Lake Country Power will be removing trees endangering power lines on 512<sup>th</sup> Lane and 221<sup>st</sup> Place in September. Mrs. Hermann will be notified of the removal of a bank near her driveway which blocks view of oncoming traffic.

**Grader:** Tire had to be repaired and the strobe light is also in need of repair.

Claims for the month were read and approved with a motion by Marvin Holsten, seconded by Fred Kamrowski.

Correspondence included letters from US Department of Commerce, Minnesota Assn of Townships and residents George and JoAnn Hudson.

**Old Business:** Township Service Day has been postponed until next year. The supervisors will not be attending the Planning Commission Meeting.

**New Business:** It was decided not to participate in the 2020 Census Local Update of Census Addresses Operation due to the time and lack of security involved.

**Other Business:** The fire extinguishers have been serviced.

Next meeting was set for September 20, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. to be held at the Town Hall. We adjourned at 10:12 a.m. with a motion by Marvin Holsten, seconded by Fred Kamrowski.
