Regular Board Meeting  
Wednesday, March 20, 2019, 4pm

Workman Township monthly meeting was called to order by Chairman Berg with all board members in attendance. There were two citizens in attendance. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all. Motion to accept the agenda was made by Kamrowski with second by Holsten. Motion carried, all voted in favor. February board meeting minutes were read by Clerk Essen. Motion to accept the minutes was made by Kamrowski, second by Holsten. Motion carried, all voted in favor. Treasurer Berg read the treasurer's report: General: 9,792.20, Road and Bridge: 5,150.48, Fire: 5,978.12, Cemetery: 1,750.45. Totaling 22,671.55. Motion to approve the treasurer's report by Kamrowski, second by Holsten. Motion carried, all voted in favor. Clerk and Treasurer accounts balance.

Fire, First Responders, Buildings report by Supervisor Holsten. No problems or activity. Motion to rent Palisade Community Center/Firehall from April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020 was made by Holsten, with second by Kamrowski. Motion carried, all voted in favor.

Cemetery report by Kamrowski. Cemetery road has been plowed for a funeral. Discussion on forming a flower club to improve the cemetery and have more citizen involvement. Additional discussion will be covered at the next monthly meeting which would involve projected costs and benefits.

Roads and grader report by Berg. There are concerns over spring flooding. Sandbags have been secured with provisions made for sand when and if needed. Culverts are checked on a regular basis to check for plugging. At this time culverts seem to be adequate.

Clerk Essen read the claims to be paid. After some discussion, motion was made by Holsten with second by Kamrowski to approve and pay claims. Motion carried, all voted in favor.

Correspondence: McGregor Fire Department Contract was received. After some discussion it was decided to continue discussion at next meeting.

New business: Meeting attended by supervisors in Duluth on culverts and maintaining them was covered. All agree that the meeting was beneficial.

FEMA payment is now estimated at 26,180.03. Payment should now be received in early July. MAT meeting will be Thursday, April 4<sup>th</sup> in Grand Rapids. All board members will attend.

Resolution was approved on vacant state and county land in Workman to be used for recreation. Motion made by Kamrowski, second by Holsten. Motion carried, all voted in favor. Resolution sent to Aitkin County Land Commissioner.

Compensation schedule was discussed with several changes made. Approved by Kamrowski, second by Holsten, motion carried with all voting in favor.

Next monthly meeting scheduled for Wednesday, April 17, 2019. Motion to Adjourn made by Kamrowski, second by Holsten at 4:49 pm. Motion carried with all voting in favor.
