MONTHLY MEETING, APRIL, 2019
PALISADE COMMUNITY CENTER/FIREHALL

Workman Township monthly board meeting was called to order by Chairman Berg at 4 pm on Wednesday April 17th. All board members were present. There were no guests or citizens in attendance. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all. (Prior to the board meeting opening Bob Graff asked questions concerning the road near his property) Motion to approve the Agenda was made by Kamrowski with a second by Holsten. Motion carried with all in favor. The March township minutes were read by Clerk Essen. Motion to approve minutes was made by Holsten with second by Kamrowski. Motion carried with all in favor. Treasurer Betty Berg read the treasurer's report giving individual totals and a grand total of \$21,783.03. The balance for the clerk and the treasurer agree. Motion to approve was made by Kamrowski with second by Holsten. Motion carried with all in favor.

Buildings, fire, first responders – Holsten. Holsten reported that everything was in order with no known problems.

Cemetery – Kamrowski. Kamrowski indicated light by cemetery needed adjustment. Tree stump is being removed, general cleanup is being done in preparation for Memorial Day program and the summer. The Memorial Day program will start with a half hour of instrumental patriotic music by a McGregor School senior, More information will be presented at the May meeting.

Roads and Grader - Berg. Berg reported that the roads are holding up fairly well even with the wet conditions. We will know more when we have our road inspection on May 9th. The grader operator will be Gary Wilkie and grading is planned to start on Saturday, May 18th.

Discussion and inspection of a possible snow plow truck will be done before the next meeting when results and details will be discussed.

Reading of the claims was made by Clerk Essen. Approval to pay was made by Holsten with second by Kamrowski. Motion approved with all in favor.

Correspondence included a proposal by Atkinson Lawn Care and also Eric's Lawn Service. Motion to accept the proposal of Atkinson Lawn Care by Holsten with second by Kamrowski. Motion approved with all in favor. MATIT Term Life Insurance for the Board information was received, reviewed, and discussed. Motion to approve the minimum policy was made by Kamrowski with second by Holsten. Motion carried with all in favor. A Minnesota Unemployment Claim was discussed and further review will be necessary. Aitkin County has informed the township that the remainder of Cty Rd 3 from the townhall to Hwy 65 will not be done this year.

Board members reported that the MAT meeting at Grand Rapids was interesting and informative. ACAT will be in McGregor on Thursday, April 18 starting at 7 pm.

Next monthly meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, May 15th at the same location. Motion to adjourn was made by Kamrowski with a second by Holsten. Meeting adjourned at 5:40 pm with all in favor.
