August 17 Meeting Minutes 4 pm

Chairman Berg opened the meeting at 4 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States Flag. No citizens or visitors were present. Approval of the Agenda was made by Supervisor Paris with second by Supervisor Jaworski. The August Meeting Minutes were read by Clerk Essen. Motion to accept was made by Paris with second by Jaworski. The Minutes will stand as read. Treasurer Berg gave her report on finances and everything is in order. The treasurer and clerk balances agree. Motion to approve the treasurer report was made by Paris with second by Jaworski.

Supervisor Jaworski gave the report on fire, first responders, buildings and no action was taken. Supervisor Jaworski is going to research both township hall building and equipment storage building and will report at a later date.

Supervisor Paris reported that the cemetery is in good shape. The memorial slab and flagpole will soon be installed. Plans are under way for the dedication of the veterans memorial monument at 10 am on Saturday, October 22nd.

Supervisor Berg reported on roads and equipment. Additional gravel is being placed on Grouse Street. Our three pieces of equipment are in good working order. Will need to find storage space for snowplow. FEMA funded culvert upgrade is completed as is the roadside weed spraying which we received a grant from the State of Minnesota.

Reading of Claims was made by Clerk Essen and after review and some discussion motion by Jaworski with second by Paris was made to pay claims.

Old business included discussion on our website provider. Several meetings are coming up and the township will have representation.

All necessary paperwork and checks were processed and signed. Next meeting set for 4pm on Wednesday, September 21st at the same location.

At 5:20 pm Supervisor Paris made the motion to adjourn with second by Supervisor Jaworski. Meeting adjourned.
